Fragment is only of the right side of a headdress. No earspool is preserved, only a decorative piece that hangs down w/ 2 vertically excised lines. Above the portion w/ the excised lines is a wider band w/ no decorative marks. Above the band is another decorative are of crossed diagonal lines making small squares... almost pineapple-patterned. No other decorative portions are preserved.
