This fragment looks to be a right earspool of a hollow figurine. It is extremely evaded, so that only the circular Shape + inner dot are clearly identifiable. It was projecting of of the head some probably somewhat independently from the face. The interior and the layers around the firing cove are an extreme orange color probably due to re-firing.
