LITTLE FIGURINE HEAD, EXTREMELY ERODED. FACIAL FEATURES LOOK HAND-CARVED NOT MOLD-MADE. FOREHEAD HAS TWO RAISED AREAS, OR LOBES, ABOVE EACH EYEBROW AND IS, GENERALLY LARGE AND ROUNDED - LACKS HEADDRESS. NO EARS OR EARSPOLS AND FACE HAS A FELINE QUALITY SUGGESTIVE OF 1/2 HUMAN 1/2 ANIMAL. EYES ARE SUNKEN
The item is: not eroded - slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded.

UNDER RAISED BROWS (WHICH ARE ALSO PART OF RAISED FOREHEAD). THE EYES ARE RAISED CIRCLES (.5cm ACROSS) WITH INDENTED DOTS FOR PUPILS. THE EYES SIT IN INCISED DEPRESSIONS WHICH SLANT OUT AND DOWN TO A POINT 1.4cm LONG x .6cm TALL. THE NOSE IS WORN MOSTLY AWAY, ITS DIMENSIONS ARE ~~7~~ .7cm WIDE x .9cm LONG MAKING IT FAT & SHORT. TWO RAISED "CHEEKS" COME IN UNDER THE EYES. THE MOUTH IS COMPLETELY WORN AWAY. 2 EXCISED SLASHES SIT UNDER THE CHEEKS RUNNING OUT FROM THE MOUTH AND COULD REPRESENT TATOOING, FACE PAINT OR FUR. THE HEAD IS, OVERALL, VERT ROUND AND HOLLOW.
