Fragment is from the objects right side of the face + only consists of part of the headdress + whole earspool. The headdress is relatively plain + has very faint incised parallel decorative lines. The earspool is very distinct + the whole is excised deep. Nice smooth

The item is: not eroded - slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded. It: has - does not have other damage. Describe: appears to broke easily + sort of fragment in layers. No other decorative features preserved.
