Additional descriptive comments on figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

PARTIAL HUMAN FACE W/ 2 EYES, NOSE, MOUTH AND LOWER BAND OF HEADDRESS VISIBLE. FIGURE IS ERODED MAKING FEATURES SOFT AND DETAILS DIFFICULT TO SEE. EYES MAY HAVE HAD ENCRUSTED PUPILS BUT THE RIGHT IS ERODED AWAY AND THE LEFT IS ENCRUSTED W/HARD GRAY DEPOSITS (PROBABLY 10YR 4/3 ASH). THE EYE IS OVAL AND DOES NOT ANGLE UP. IT IS 1.3CM LONG X .6CM TALL. THE EYEBROW IS THIN AND RAISED AND ARCHES OVER THE FULL LENGTH OF THE EYE. THE REMAINS OF THE ITEM IS: not eroded - slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded.

THE HEADRESS BEGINS .7CM ABOVE THE EYEBROW AND IS A PLAIN BAND. THE NOSE IS DAMAGED AND BADLY ERODED, WHAT REMAINS PROTRUDES .58CM FROM THE FACE AND IS 1.1CM WIDE. THE MOUTH IS DIRECTLY UNDER THE NOSTRIL-LESS NOSE. IT IS A TINY OVAL (.9CM LONG X .3CM TALL) W/OUT TEETH, ITS SIZE, ALONG WITH THE OVAL CHALKY WHITE DEPOSITS INSIDE IT, MAKE IT IMPOSSIBLE TO TELL IF IT WAS OPEN OR CLOSED. HARD GRAY DEPOSITS OBSCURE PART OF THE HEADRESS, LEFT EYE AND INTERIOR AND WHITISH DEPOSITS ARE VISIBLE IN THE MOUTH AND RIGHT EYE. THE INTERIOR IS EXTREMELY LUMPY. HEAD WAS PROBABLY HOLLOW WHEN COMPLETE.
