SMALL RIGHT SIDE FRAGMENT OF HEADDRESS AND EARSPPOOL - ALSO A POSSIBLE EAR DEPICTED. HEADDRESS SECTION IS A SMALL ROUNDED FLARE (1.8cm x 1.3cm). THE "EAR" IS AN INCISED HALF CIRCLE JUST ABOVE THE EARSPPOOL (.98cm ACROSS). A SMALL PORTION OF THE FOREHEAD IS ALSO PRESERVED. THIS HEAD WOULD HAVE BEEN QUITE SMALL & HOLLOW. FAINT TRACES OF PAINT/SLIP (RED) ARE PRESERVED.
