Additional descriptive comments on figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

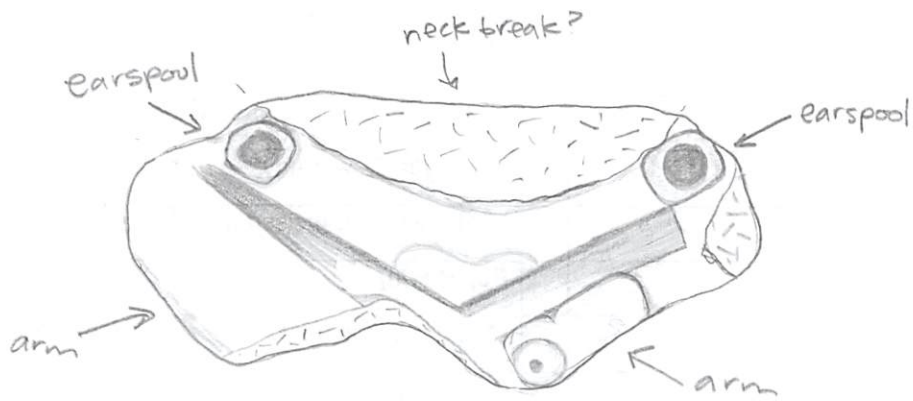
This is a piece of the chest of a figurine, including two earspools, a collar, and two arms, (one partially broken off). It seems like the head was a solid piece attached to a hollow body, and it broke off just at the neck. This piece has a front and back, and a hollow on the bottom, which probably led to a hollow body cavity. The collar is flat + diamond-shaped, with the earspools at the corners. The arms are square + undetailed, and bent in ~~the~~ against the body.

The item is: not eroded - slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded.
