SMALL CRUDLY MADE ANIMAL (DOG-LIKE) FIGURINE. BODY MAY HAVE BEEN HOLLOW BUT HEAD IS SOLID. MAY HAVE HAD LEGS, BUT THEY ARE BROKEN OFF. HAND-MOLDED HEAD HAS A SHORT SNOUT (PROBABLY PINCHED) WITH HASTILY INCISED MOUTH, EYES, AND NOSTRILS. CRUDE BUMPS MAY SIGNIFY EARS, LEFT SIDE HAS 3 INCISED SLASHES IN THE EAR AREA
