PARTIAL HUMAN FACE WITH RIGHT EYE, NOSE (W/OUT NOSTRILS), AND RIGHT HALF OF MOUTH DISCERNABLE. FITTED WITH 202AA/141-2 THE MOUTH IS COMPLETE. THE BREAK B/T THE 2 PIECES SPLITS THE MOUTH DIAGONALLY DOWN FROM THE LEFT SIDE OF THE NOSE. THE RIGHT EYE IS COMPLETE; PUPIL IS SMALL (.2cm) AND EYE SLANTS OUT AND UP SLIGHTLY (1.3cm LONG X .5cm). THE NOSE IS LUMPY & W/OUT NOSTRILS (PROTRUDES 1.2cm FROM FACE AND IS 1.5cm WIDE). THERE IS AN

INDENTATION (CIRCULAR AND CLEARLY MADE PRE-FIRING) DIRECTLY ABOVE THE RIGHT EYE (.6cm ACROSS). THE MOUTH IS OVAL AND MAY HAVE HAD TEETH (PROBABLY 2) MOUTH IS APPROX. 2.1cm ACROSS X 1.1cm TALL. FACE IS FAIRLY ERODED.
