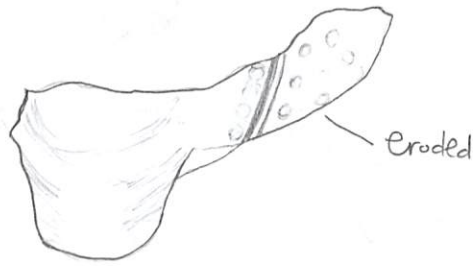
Additional descriptive comments on figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

This mysterious fragment has one large curved section decorated with panels of dots, (molded) and a small pinched slab foot extending off of it, that seems to have been molded as well. due to the width of this piece, it is hard to categorize this piece - it might be a foot with the hem of a costume (the decorated piece) or it might be a part of a headdress, and the small slab foot is a projection off of it. Neither seems like a particularly definitive identification. There is orange slip (Munsell: 5YR 7/8) on the entire outside, even the unfinished back side of the figurine. Inside, the seam between the two pieces is still visible, and there's slip there, too.
