VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This is a partial - whole elongated-U strap handle from a ladle censer.

It is the: upper proximal - lower proximal - medial - distal end - piece.

The join with the bowl is not visible.

The upper side is finished by smoothing - burnishing - scraping - wiping - striating - other (describe). *too heavily eroded to tell.*
