QUARTZITE STONE, ROUNDED (PROBABLY IN THE RIVER). FATTER SIDE
FITS WELL IN THE HAND. NARROW SIDE HAS AN AREA ALONG ITS
EDGE (2.6cm LONG X 1.1cm WIDE) WHICH IS SMOOTH & SHINY. THIS
MAY HAVE BEEN THE RESULT OF USING THE STONE TO POLISH OR
BURNISH CERAMIC VESSELS
