The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: No firing core; Horizontal striations on the exterior, various directions on the interior, over the clay on both sides; Dense deposit of clay as thick as 0.3 cm extending over the lip and for 4 cm over the exterior base, not on the neck, and very thin over the interior base for 4.1 cm back from the lip.
