The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: clay up to 0.5 cm thick is spattered densely over the entire exterior of the base, extending somewhat less densely 1.7 cm up onto the necks exterior and, thinner still, for 3.8 cm back from the basal lip on the base's interior; horizontal striations on both surfaces, including over the clay; no firing cone.
