Comments: No Firing core; Horizontal striations on the interior and exterior;
Clay as thick as 0.5 cm covers the exterior base, extending up the neck
for at least 2.2 cm; clay thin out and extends 2.4 cm back from the lip on
the interior base; Base is outflaring for 4 cm.
