Comments: 'b' lip on base; Flat top lip; no firing cone; striated horizontally on the exterior and in various directions on the interior; Baked clay as thick as 0.3cm covers the base exterior and extends up to the neck but only 0.1cm over the neck's basal exterior; clay extends 2-8cm over the interior of the base from the lip - thinner than on the exterior (as though the sand was pushed into wet clay). Neck: 5.2cm high
BASE: 6.3cm (circumference).
Some clay smeared over the neck/base join on the interior.
