Comments: Slightly flattened top, 1/2" lip on the base; no firing core; some faint horizontal striations over the clay on the exterior, in various directions on the interior, including over the clay; clay as thick as 0.6cm covers the exterior base and neck up to 0.5cm of the top; a thin clay layer extends 2cm back from the lip on the interior.
