The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments:

Firing core: FAINT central.

STRATIFICATIONS: horizontal (interior); various directions (exterior), over the clay on the exterior.

Clay: At thick as 0.3 cm, over the lip, extending up to 1.4 cm below the lip; interior: thinner, extends 2 cm back from the basal lip continues on both sides.

Neck: 5.7 cm high, vertical, (1.2 cm lip top across)

BASE: 3.2 cm across, outflaring "2" lip.

Clay seam: neck/base interior join.

Burning: more pronounced on the upper 3/4 of the neck paste than below.
