The piece is: slightly - moderately very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: ^{Base piece} Clay up to 0.3cm thick densely encrusts the exterior base up to the neck and continues in a thinner deposit over the lip and for 3.1cm onto the interior of the base; 6" lip on the base; vertical neck?, at least 2.2cm high; the base is outflaring and 5cm across; The interior neck/base junction is sharp while rounded on the exterior; horizontal striations on the interior and exterior
