The piece is: slightly — moderately — very — extremely — eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: No firing core; vertical neck 3.5 cm high; base is outflaring  
5.5 cm long; ~~no~~ sharp neck/base junction on the interior and rounded on  
the exterior; flat top, 6 mm lip on the base; clay up to 0.3 cm thick,  
extends densely over the base's exterior, thinning out considerably  
over the neck, lip, and for 1.8 cm onto the base's interior; horizontal  
striations on the interior and exterior.
