The - upper - lower - both - neither - edge(s) is/are chipped

Clay from making other vessels is baked on the exterior - interior - both sides - neither side very little

How many layers of clay are there? 1 - more than one (give the number):

Give the Munsell designation for the clay color: 5YR 8/3 (1 slab)

Is the color of the stand altered from reheating: yes - no - can't tell exterior only

Give the Munsell designation for the stand: paste interior - 7.5YR 7/4 paste exterior - 7.5YR 7/4

Discolored exterior: 5YR 7/8

Describe the location and nature of the use wear if present:

The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Not drawn - Drawn - where? Back.

Comments: Thick centrally located firing core. Striations in all directions on the neck's exterior and interior - on the bases base's interior. The striations run horizontally. Banded gray and orange on the exterior - ca. 30% gray and 70% orange.
