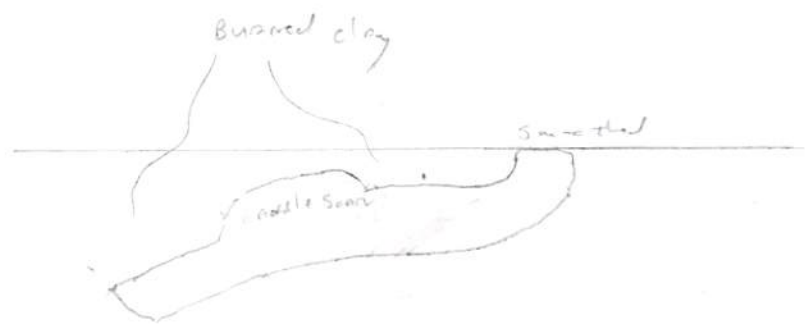
Describe the location and nature of the use wear if present:

A Handle scar, 1.9cm in diameter, survives on the shoulder. No firing core. The upper, lighter color clay may not have been fired as often or as hot as the underlying clay level.
