SCARIFICATIONS: Horizontal, both sides, including over the lower clay level on the exterior.

Clay: <sup>exterior</sup> 2.5cm thick as 0.3cm, over the lip and the base, over the neck, up to the top, thinning on the neck; interior: thinner, 4.8cm back from the lip on the base

neck: 1.4cm, vertical but grooved circumferentially, 12cm lip

Base: 6cm across, cur flaring, 1.2cm lip.
