Firing core: no  
STRIATIONS: Horizontal on both sides, not over the clay.  
exterior:  
clay: as thick as 0.2 cm, over the lip, densely over the base,  
and up the neck to the flat lip; interior: thinner, 2.4 cm  
back from the lip on the base. Some mica in the clay.  
neck: 1.9 cm high, out slanting; flat lip  
Base: 3.7 cm across, out flaring, 'v' lip
