Comments: Firing core: no  
Stratifications: Horizontal, both sides, includes exterior, over the clay on the interior.  
Clay: as thick as 0.5cm, continuous over the lip, base, and neck  
with top lip, equally thick throughout; interior; thinner, continuous, 4.4cm back from the lip.  
neck: 2.9cm high, vertical, 1.1cm lip (1.1cm across)  
Base: 5.6cm across, outflaring, "L" lip.  
Clay seam: neck/base interior join.
