Comments: Centrally located firing core; horizontal striations on the interior and exterior; baked clay is thick & as a clay extends from burner over the lip back to the neck on the exterior, thinning out as it continues 1.8cm up the neck exterior; a thinner, but continuous, clay level projects 2.9cm back from the lip on the base interior; some str. horizontal striations over the clay on the neck exterior.
Base is outflaring and 5.9cm long; neck is vertical and at least 4.8cm high.
