Rising core: no
Stratifications: horizontal, both; include over the clay, exterior
clay: as thick as 0.2cm, continuous over the lip, base, and
neck up to the top; interior: thinner, spotty, 5.4cm back
from the lip.
Neck: 2.2cm high, vertical, rim lip (0.2cm across)
Base: 5.4cm across, out flaring "2" lip.
