STRATIFICATIONS: horizontal (interior), including over the clay; not visible on the exterior.

Clay: very thick up to 0.5 cm thick / and dense on all exterior surfaces, somewhat thinner, but extensive on the interior base

Clay seam: neck/base interior joint.

neck: 1.2 cm high, vertical, flared lip.

Base: 4.4 cm across, outflaring, 1/4 lip.
