The - upper - lower - both - neither - edge(s) is/are chipped

Clay from making other vessels is baked on the exterior - interior - both sides - neither side

How many layers of clay are there? 1 - more than one (give the number):

Give the Munsell designation for the clay color: (covered with a white deposit.)

The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: widely scattered clay blobs on the exterior neck and base;  
STRIATED in various directions on both sides (not over the clay);  
FLAT top; "b" lip on the base; central firing cone; Discoloration  
from burning onto exterior and 0.3cm into the paste;  
Neck Height: 6.4cm, clear interior base junction with the base;  
Base = 4.2cm long + out flaring.
