Clay from making other vessels is baked on the exterior - interior - both sides - neither side

How many layers of clay are there? 1 - more than one (give the number): 2

The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Not drawn Drawn-where? Back.

Comments: No firing core; clay as thick as 0.2cm (wards) from the base edge up onto the neck to 1.2cm below the rim; handle (strip now to shoulder depth) survives (4.9cm, 1.7cm<sup>w</sup>, 1.7cm<sup>th</sup>) and the clay goes 3.1cm up on interior and exterior; a thinner layer of clay extends 2cm from the basal edge onto the interior base surface; some isolated spots are found on the neck interior up to 2.3cm below the rim.
