STRIATIONS: ^{not over the clay} VARIOUS directions (interior); can't tell on the exterior.
Clay: as thick as 0.3cm on the exterior, over the lip and back to the neck; interior, thinner, back to the neck.
Clay seam: at the neck/base join on the interior
neck: 1.4cm high, vertical, flat lip
Base: 7.8cm across, outflaring, 'f' lip.
