The piece is: slightly moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: A Base Fragment with a rounded lip; the clay is 0.5cm thick (maximum) and extends thickly and densely over all of the exposed base's & exterior surface; continues in a thinned deposit over the lip and for 1.5cm into the interior; no firing cone; striated in various directions on the interior - can't tell on the exterior - not striated over the clay.
