Clay from making other vessels is baked on the exterior - interior - both sides - neither side

How many layers of clay are there? 1 - more than one (give the number): 3

Is the color of the stand altered from reheating? yes - no - can't tell

The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: clay as much as 0.4cm thick extends over all of the base area  
top to bottom, thinning slightly on the neck; and slightly onto the basal lip  
no firing core;  
Horizontal STRATIFIED interior and exterior.
