STRATIFICATIONS: Horizontal interior and exterior, over the clay on both sides  
exterior  
clay: AS thick AS 0.5cm applied thickly over the lip and over the  
neck but not on the flat top; interior: from the lip on to the neck up  
to 0.5cm below the top -- thin but more - at least uniform and  
continuous.

neck: 1.4cm high, vertical, flat lip.

Base: 5cm across, curflaring, 1/2" lip.
