Comments: no firing core; horizontal striations on the interior base and all of the exterior, including over the clay, in various directions on the neck interior; clay up to 0.4cm thick densely covers the exterior base over the lip -- up to, but not on, the neck exterior; clay (slightly thinner) extends up to 4.4cm back from the lip on the base's interior.
