The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: No firing core; core looks more discolored from firing than the surface -- the exterior being lightly discolored and the interior not at all; clay as thick as 0.1cm covers the 'a' lip of the base and extends up onto <sup>and covers</sup> the surviving neck, continuing 2.7cm onto the base's interior, which has the same thickness and high density -- base is curflaring; A marked neck/base join; base is 4.9cm long.
