Clay from making other vessels is baked on the exterior - interior - both sides - neither side

Comments: Firing core: POINT, central.  
Striations: horizontal all surfaces, lumpy neck interior  
Clay <sup>exterior</sup> is thick as 0.3cm, continuous over the lip, across the base  
and on the neck to the top lip, slightly thinner near the top  
interior: thinner, sparser, 2.2cm back from the lip.  
Neck: 5.8cm high, slightly concave on the interior, 1.1cm lip. 1.1cm across  
Base: 5cm across, no flaring "3" lip.  
Clay seam: neck/base interior join
