Comments: firing core: no
neck: 3.6cm high, slightly convex (interior), flat lip.
Base: At least 4cm across, slightly concave (interior).
Clay: up to 0.1cm thick over the visible shoulder/base up to the flat top on the exterior, thinning as it goes up the neck.
