Fragment has been heavily fired b/c ~~very~~ very pink; however very little baked on clay. Only 2 slight <sup>smearings</sup> ~~clips~~ of baked on clay. Exterior is pink all over. Interior is pink in the middle of the body. The lip + edge toward the base a gray + dark from firing.
