Firing core: no  
 clay: both sides  
 a spotty, discontinuous distribution, as thick as 0.3cm,  
 but rarely so, scattered over the shoulder  
 neck: 4.5cm high, outcurving, flat top  
 base: 5.2cm across, concave interior / convex exterior,  
 smoothed / ground edge.
