The piece is: slightly - moderately - very - extremely - eroded / is not eroded.

Comments: Covered with very thick clay deposit that obscures all surfaces.

Firing cone: no

Stratification: horizontal on the interior, not over the clay.

Clay: up to 1.5cm thick over the lip and up to the top, thinning slightly near the top; interior: thinner, but up to 0.2cm thick in spots, covers the base and most of the neck.

Neck: 5.4cm high, vertical, flared lip clay access.
Base: 3.8cm across, outflaring "lip".
