Comments:

Fragment is of a grounded down base w/ nearly all of the neck present. Interior is very smooth + finished; no baked on clay present. Exterior is horizontally striated. Base has been chipped + smoothed, but is also broken + eroded due to poor preservation. The upper portion could have been chipped down for stand use

Comments cont'd:

Interior near base is also warm down due use as the base/lower portion of the vessel. Interior is a darker gray color than ^{the} brown-colored exterior.
