The - upper - lower - both (neither) - edge(s) is/are chipped *→ upper exterior has an accidental/erosional chip*

Clay from making other vessels is baked on the exterior - interior - both sides - (neither side)

Comments: *Large Finlay Cave. This piece was originally an A-Jar; grinding prevents exact characterization; however it has been ground to sit like a D-Jar. The upper edge is ground flat at such an angle that only the interior edge is flat and the exterior edge is not even.*
