It is pierced: y n on its way.

The pierced hole is biconically drilled: y n only stated so only ext has a slight depression

The margin/edge was chipped to form the disk: y n

Comments:
Erosion has gotten such that there are no edges. The whole was not started on the back yet. Some parts of margin are smoother than others, even w/ some rounding of rim; however, not clear use and depression is very obviously diff → Spindle wheel
