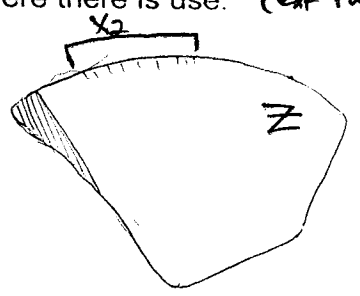

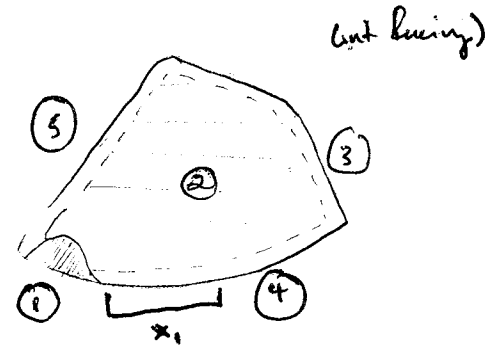

Describe the use: 6 definitely smoothed to a nice slant from the rest of 5, w/ flattening 6 extending over the point. The wear stops about 3/4 through the margin and does not proceed to the interior edge.
4 (see comments) SCRN



Comments:

- ① chip out of margin + interior edge
- ② the dotted line surrounding two marks of a uniformly differential band of wear around the better preserved, general interior surface; ③ + ④ have clearly discernable crisp ~~edges~~ that accompany non-worked margins
- ④ minus the chip is a ground flat, smoothed margin that displays differential use wear at X_{1,2} in the margin, which smoother, and in the very rounded exterior edge (the interior edge is unburnt w/ the erosional band)
