The shape of the object is approximately: triangular – square – rectangular – oval – tear-drop – other (describe):

The margin/edge was chipped to form the item: y - n ^{↳ one side only}

The margin/edge was deliberately ground to smooth it: y - n

The margin/edge is smoothed from use: y - n

There is other use wear visible: y - n

Trace the item on the reverse, both frontal view and profile, and show where there is use.

Describe the use:

USE-wear area extends partially across item. The area between the top & bottom edges has been smoothed over. covers an area of approximately 6cm²
USE area is smoother than rest of sherd

The type-variety from which this was made is: PN

Comments: This is a rim fragment that has been slightly modified to form the Δ shape. The overall thickness of item is not consistent & suggests variation result of use. Also the variation in thickness is a result from this fragment being the junction between the handle & rim of jar.

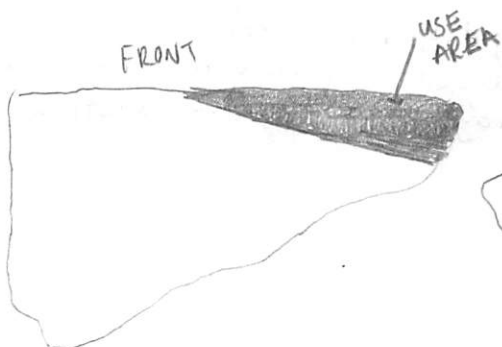
