The shape of this object is approximately: triangular - square - rectangular - oval - tear-drop - other (describe):

The margin/edge was chipped to form the item: y (n) ~~(~~chipped~~ ~~to~~ ~~form~~ ~~the~~ ~~item~~)~~

The margin/edge was deliberately ground to smooth it: y (n) side ①, not too smooth, but definitely a little, it was not ground to reshape the object.

The margin/edge is smoothed from use: y (n)

There is other use wear visible: y (n)

Describe the use: ② very slight rounding w/ diff texture and color on exterior edge; however (ext flung)
The interior is ~~the~~ definitely the main site of use, especially under the point

The type-variety from which this was made is: PN.

Comments:

- ① just a flat, round break w/ a slant to it
crisp edges, rough margin.
- ② is a rough chip
- ④ displays differential erosion on both interior and exterior edges, but b/c the margin is rough, and at the edges would not be used w/o the margin b/c of the slight concavity, thus, I think it is only differential erosion
