The shape of this object is approximately triangular - square - rectangular - oval - tear-drop - other (describe):

The margin/edge was chipped to form the item: y - n

The margin/edge was deliberately ground to smooth it: y - n

Describe the use: X IS A BROAD, SLIGHTLY CONVEX, INT EDGE COMPLETELY ROUNDED OVER, BUT ~~SHARP~~ ABRUPTLY ENDING AT CORNER W/ Y. X SLIGHTLY WRAPS AROUND TO THE EXTERIOR WHERE DISCOLORED SCRAPE MARKS ARE BARELY PRESENT. Y IS A RELATIVELY VERTICAL MARGIN W/ BOTH EDGES WORN, ALTHOUGH THE EXT IS MORE USED.

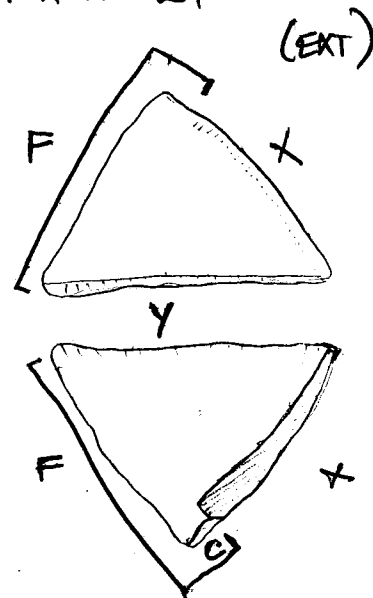
