VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This worked sherd is intact: y - n. (minus chomp)

If no, approximately what percentage is preserved (give a number):

The shape of this object is approximately: triangular - square - rectangular - oval - tear-drop - other (describe): The chomp got hid of one of the defined points.

A scribed/lightly incised line demarcating the circumference is visible: y - n

The margin/edge was chipped to form the item: y - n

The margin/edge was deliberately ground to smooth it: y - n

The margin/edge is smoothed from use: y - n

There is other use wear visible: y - n

Trace the item on the reverse, both frontal view and profile, and show where there is use.

Describe the use: ① roughest edge, just chipped ①a slight overhang, very smooth underside, as well as smoothed exterior edge. ② pretty rough, concave. ②a slight overhang, smoothed interior edge. ③ smoothed light overhang that becomes more pronounced as you get to ③/② base. The type-variety from which this was made is: PIT

②a / ②a smoothing wraps under the point and touches each other.

Both interior and exterior faces are moderately eroded, w/ the temper popping out.
