The shape of this object is approximately: triangular - square - rectangular - oval - tear-drop - other (describe):

2.6 x 2.6 x 2.7 pretty equal triangular lateral.

A scribed/lightly incised line demarcating the circumference is visible: y - n

Comments: Interior is darkened around generally, but most concentrated on edges. Exterior edges + lip darkened as well. (1) < (2), and (2) < (3) are very faint while (1) < (3) is rounded off.
